PRADA GROUP "SHAPING A SUSTAINABLE MULTILATERALISM" CONFERENCE TO BE HELD AT CA' CORNER DELLA REGINA IN VENICE ON SEPTEMBER 1ST 2020

Milan, August 25th 2020

On September 1st 2020, the Prada Group will host a closed-door conference at Ca' Corner della Regina in Venice, one of the Fondazione Prada's venues, as part of the "Shaping a Future" cultural events created to stimulate a debate on the most significant changes taking place in contemporary society.

The conference is part of a two-day-event promoted by the newly constituted *Soft Power Club*, a private organization aiming at promoting cultural diplomacy and multilateral relationships among members of the public and private sector for the progress of society.

During the morning debate – which will be introduced by Carlo Mazzi as both founding member of the Club and Chairman of Prada S.p.A. – speakers will discuss how sustainability, as a cultural lever, could be the engine to develop multilateral relationships and agreements.
